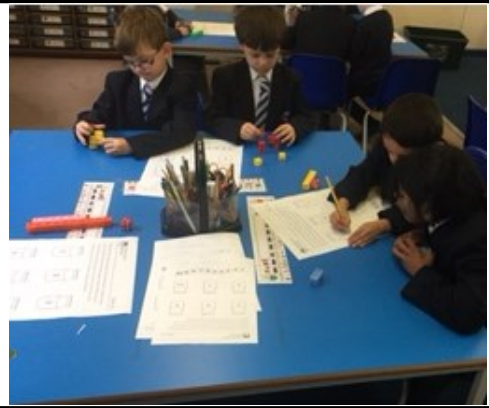




MATHS MASTERY



The children use cubes to find the answers to addition and subtraction equations. They used the cubes to find the whole and the parts of a number



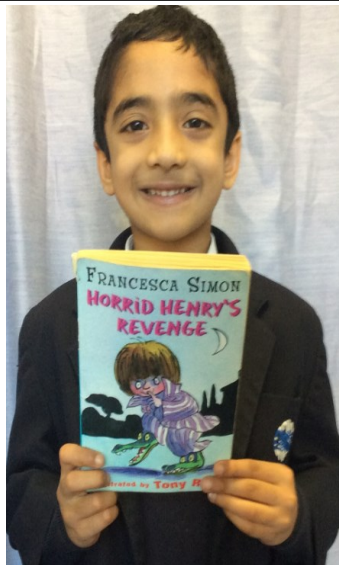
READING

RE: Role and Responsibilities
